

Dear members and friends of Holy Trinity,

We are writing to inform you of important decisions made by our church council at our meeting on December 10th. Given the increase in COVID 19 cases, the council has decided to remain open for in-person Sunday services for Sunday, December 20th and also for Thursday, December 24th, Christmas Eve. Holy Trinity will then suspend in-person worship until a date, possibly in January, when conditions will be more conducive to in-person worship. Be assured that the remote service will continue to be sent by both email and Facebook in the weeks ahead.

In addition, the council decided to postpone the annual congregation meeting scheduled for Sunday, **January 24th 2021** until Sunday, June 20th. The council members will remain in their leadership positions until the meeting in June.

A further detail to note concerns the Christmas Eve worship service at 7pm on December 24th. The council asks that you call to indicate your plans to attend and how many will be with you.
